A HyperGuide to Library Facilities & Services

Finding that elusive bit of information about one of the dozens of campus libraries has just become easier. The UC Berkeley Library has developed a hypermedia guide to campus library facilities and services using HyperCard® on the Macintoshtm. The Library HyperGuide is designed to present a large amount of information about the Library and its services in an engaging, easy-to-use format.

The guide is not a linear tutorial, in which you would be restricted to one particular path through the information. Instead you can dip into the information as deeply or as superficially as you like, and you can quit at any time from any location within the guide. Each screen of information has built-in links to other screens that may offer more detail or information on a related topic. This hypermedia format allows you to be in control of your interaction with the guide and can therefore be used for a quick lookup or for leisurely browsing.

The HyperGuide has basic information (hours, location on campus, telephone numbers, etc.) on all 26 branches of The Library as well as other Libary public service units and many of the independent campus libraries.


